
How to Use These Task Cards

These **Interview Questions 4 Getting a Job**, includes way over 100 task cards to copy, cut out, and use in classroom discussions. Several ideas and suggested uses are:


- ▣ Assign each student a question that they will address in front of their classmates, within a small group, or for one on one role play.
- ▣ As the teacher you can grab a random card and present it to the class to elicit response.
- ▣ Use these cards intermittently for break times or to start discussions.
- ▣ Student feedback is an important objective when answering the questions. Set a criteria to achieve, let the students know what they need to aim for, then critique their answers as if you were the interviewer.
- ▣ Job interview questions are about the quality of the response to the situation posed.
- ▣ These questions are great preparation for assimilating and presenting thoughts. The following page has a suggested guidebook that may be of interest.


