# Lesson Overview Teacher Tips & Suggestions

There are 3 progressive, yet inter-related activities. It's suggested each stage is presented in order. Time duration: 20-30 m nutes per activity and 10 minutes for intro and wrap-up. (Ap, ima aly 90 minutes total.)

Activities can use a whiteboard, or as handouts, or st on a bulletin board. Activities can be used in ar or independently.

### **How Can We Help the Homeless?**

Who is considered homeless? If you are homeless you are living in shelters, parks, motels, hotels, public spaces, camerounes, cars, abandoned buildings, or temporarily living with other parks.

Homelessness is a complex social problem with a rie v of underlying economic and social factors. The top causes of homelessness are:

- (1) Lack of affordable housing
- (2) Unemployment
- (3) Poverty
- (4) Mental and/or physical disabili,
- (5) Substance abuse and/or adriction.
- (6) Situational Circumstance: In orce, la fal eviction, foreclosure
- (7) Natural Disasters: hurricane, arthquake, or flood

As of 2018 the US Department using reports there were around 553,000 homeless per in the U.S.A. (0.17% of the population).
