




# Thumbnails are Important To Help Customers Visualize

All finished products start with a concept.


Thumbnails help set the intention of the final piece.

# How to Make a Thumbnail In Scale & Size


Thumbnails are drawn small in size. Sketches are about one nuarter לו the actual size. Thus ג ופ וויאר thumbnail sketches.


